Our Campground is nestled in the beautiful Berks County Wilderness along a mountain where the Saucony Creek flows.

Camp Begins every Wednesday Morning until Saturday Afternoon. Campers take part in Chapel Sessions, Cabin devotions and one to one time with there camp counsellor.

There is always something to do with Camp Activities as well as Elective Camp Activities. Many of the Elective Activities are off site like a visit to Dorney Park Wild water Kingdom, or going underground deep into Crystal Cave!

Saucony Campers live in air-conditioned cabins and are supervised by a senior counselor and an Assistant CIT (Counselor in Training) The camp has beautiful restroom facilities, with toilets, showers, and running water.



Our Program at Saucony is a unique Camping Experience that sets apart our campers from the normal everyday schedules and technology's of life.

We do not ALLOW Electronic Devices, iPod, Cellphones, Video Games, Etc.

All of these items must be left at home!

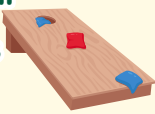
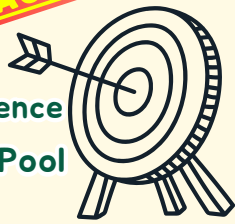

## PRICING:

It is the Goal of our ministry and leadership to provide an affordable Summer Camp experience for as many families as possible.

While we have a flat rate for camp.

We also have several opportunities to possibly subsidize our camp program.

We believe every child should experience overnight camp. We work confidentially with each family to handle your registration and payments.

Our Ministry never wants finances to be a barrier for youth to come and experience all that camp has to offer them. We will work hard to connect you with various options that help with paying for camp such as our amazing donors, churches, and local business people that share our vision in keeping camp affordable & accessible to families like yours.

**Our Weekly Rate : \$150.00**

This Includes 3 meals and an evening snack daily along with all activites and programs.

If you need Assistance THERE IS HELP AVAILABLE THROUGH Open Door Mission Miracle Life Church. The church will pay up to 50%. per week

Deposits: All weeks require a non-refundable deposit to hold your spot. The Deposit is \$50 that will be removed from your balance. The Remaining balance is due one week before the start of your camp week. Failure to follow these guidelines can result in cancellation of your campers session.

Our Campground operates on a first come first serve basis!

It is important that you get you camp paperwork and deposit into the office ASAP!!

## MEDICATIONS:

Please have any medications ready to be turned in labeled with your camper's name. They must be properly labeled with your camper's name, along with any instructions (i.e. taken with food, avoid, etc.). All medications (prescription and over the counter) must be in the original bottle from the pharmacy and turned into our Staff. In the case of a serious medical condition, there may be occasions where a camper may keep medication with them (Epipen, insulin, etc.).
